Ms. Hedren is very involved with international conservation groups to save wildlife. She serves on the board of The Wildlife Safari, The Elsa Wild Animal Appeal, and the Earth Communications Office. She is "den mother" to over sixty big cats (lions, tigers, leopards, cougars, and serval cats) at the Roar Foundation's Shambala Preserve near Acton, California.
