Re: SPOOKY SNOOZE Family Overnights at the Palm Beach Zoo

West Palm Beach, Florida, September 21, 2011 – The Palm Beach Zoo will host a Halloween-themed overnight program for children ages 6 and over, accompanied by Mummies and/or Daddies. Sleepovers will take place on October 1, 8, 15, 22, and 29 from 6:30 PM through 8:30 AM.

The program will include up-close animal encounters, pumpkin painting, crafts, night time zoo tours, a “spooky” snack, and story time. Participants will sleep in the “Pioneer House” in the Florida section of the zoo. Sleeping areas have electrical outlets but are not heated or air-conditioned. Shower facilities are not available. A continental breakfast is included. Activities are geared for children ages 6 and up: Mummies and/or Daddies must attend!

The fee for Spooky Snooze is \$30 per person for Members or \$35 per person for non-members.
